# Inclusion of the Poor

- Before the Poverty scorecard exercise, the poorest HHs were not identified properly. There was no record of their inclusion in COs
- Poverty scorecard exercise disclosed that out of 113 poorest HHs, not even one HH was included in COs
- All 113 HHs were included into COs through special campaigns
- CIF loan was given to each of those HHs from the next tranche of CIF

# Internal Resource Mobilisation

## Results of year 2008

- Collection from wheat: Rs. 22,350
- Collection from Qurbani Hides: Rs. 12,400
- Estimated collection from rice and cotton:  
Rs. 22,000

**Total collection for year 2008: Rs.56,750**

# Micro credit for poor members from CIF

## Criteria

1. Lending to poor people only
2. Priority will be given to women
3. For those who do not have NIC and can not acquire loans from any other financial institution
4. Lending also for those younger than 21 years and older than 65 years
5. Preference given to productive loans

# Major Achievements

1. Organised 100% poorest HHs into COs and gave loans from CIF
2. Local fund raising through self-help initiatives (wheat, cotton, rice, etc)
3. Fund raising from internal resources (Rs.2.1 million)
4. Provided CM's Food Stamp scheme to 40 poorest HHs
5. Linkages developed with donor agencies (Social Welfare, SPO, TVO, etc)

6. Provided free legal support to poor HHs
7. Free medical aid to 25 HHs
8. National Identity Cards by NADRA for 633 people
9. Vaccination of 612 animals with support from PRSP and training of CLEWS

# Future Planning

1. Transform individual thinking into collective thinking
2. Enrolment of 100% children into schools
3. Adult literacy programme for women
4. Mother and Child centre to be established
5. Establishment of vocational centres for women
6. Providing support to poorest HHs from Benazir Income Support Programme, Zakat and Bait-ul-Maal

7. Measures to control drugs
8. Programmes to promote positive activities amongst youngsters
9. Installation of water filtration plants in each village
10. Maximum utilisation of services of CLEWS for livestock management and treatment

11. Promote collective enterprises at local level
12. Formation of Nonihal VDO for children
13. Sewerage, affordable latrine and garbage collection projects for clean environment
14. Establish library for children with books on famous personalities
15. Ambulance facility
16. Stop child labour

17. Start tent and crockery services as business for LSO income
18. Contact experts to improve agriculture productivity
19. Arrangement of latest agricultural technology and machinery at LSO level
20. Training to promote new technology/machinery in agriculture
21. Formation of committee to help form LSOs in other areas
22. To discuss and plan with COs/VDOs for the proper utilisation of savings

23. Organise workshops and lectures for religious harmony
24. Link skilled people to formal markets in order to sell their products for better prices
25. Establishment of mobile utility store at UC level
