Narration

Community Critical Infrastructure (CCIs)

Construction of CCIs remains in progress and by the 31st of August 201 schemes had been completed while 31 are in the final stages of completion. The delay in the completion of the 31 CCIs was due to delays in the release of funds which affected field work.

In the desert areas where communities face an acute water shortage, some of the VDMCs have constructed more than one water reservoir without disturbing the budget lines

Meetings held between VDMCs/UDMCs at Union Council Level

Regular meetings were held at UDMC/VDMC level to discuss the current situation and progress, as well as activities and roles and responsibilities of these community based institutions. These meetings provide an effective platform to discuss potential issues and possible solutions. The main points brought up and discussed during these meetings were as follows:

- UDMCs are engaged in networking at the Taluka and District levels to effectively coordinate with Government, line agencies and other stakeholders to handle unforeseen disasters.
- Planning various scenarios for potential disasters and share their detail (*Cell numbers, Village/settlement names* and other relevant information) with DDMA focal person in the district government.
- VDMC to ensure inclusion of representatives of the most vulnerable groups in VDMC.
- UDMC's plans to disseminate emergency information to VDMCs and issue early warnings and possible rescue point information.
- UDMC will facilitate the community during any emergency.
- VDMC to ensure the Critical Community Infrastructures (CCIs) is properly executed at the VDMC level.
- UDMC to conduct regular meetings with VDMCs and update their records on given registers.
- UDMC is also taking care of the emergency tool kit

External Evaluation:

After properly scrutinizing proposals, a consultancy contract was awarded to the highest ranking bidder. The External Evaluation team visited the project districts to collect first-hand information and data regarding the project. The team visited different communities, CCIs, government officials and conducted detailed survey. Several Key informants were also interviewed by the evaluation team in all 4 districts.

Provincial Experience Sharing Workshop:

Rural Support Program Network (RSPN) organized a one day Provincial Experience Sharing workshop under the Tahafuz CBDRM Project on August 23rd, 2013 at Hotel Mehran in Karachi. Participants from TRDP, NRSP, government officials, representatives of other NGOs and VDMC-UDMC members attended the workshop. RSPN CEO also participated in the workshop. Members from partner RSPs gave presentations on the project activities and shared their experiences in the field. Government officials and members from other N.G.Os also addressed the participants of the workshop. A detailed report of the event has already been submitted.

Branding & Marking (Project Video Clips):

To highlight the particular achievements and activities of the project two short video clips were produced by RSPN. For this purpose RSPN hired a team of professional photographers and videographers. The team visited 2 districts of the project Tharparkar and Thatta to capture on site activities. The team of videographers recorded clips on trainings, linkages and CCI. The raw clippings of the clips have been shared with RSPN and the final videos will be handed over after completion of post-production.
